### Flight Information

**Paro** airport is the meeting place for this tour. Drukair, the national airline, is the only carrier serving Bhutan, with a limited service into Paro. Your Drukair flights from Kathmandu or Delhi will be organised by Kudu in conjunction with the Ministry of Protocol in Bhutan.

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You will need to book your flights to and from **Kathmandu or Delhi**. Please plan to arrive in Kathmandu or Delhi on 5 November and spend a night there. We can advise you on accommodation options. ### **Visa and Health Requirements**

#### *BHUTAN*

All visitors require a valid passport and a visa for entry to Bhutan - visa support service is organised by Kudu Travel (paperwork will be sent to you for completion) and the cost is included in the trip price.

#### *NEPAL*

Most visitors require a valid passport and a visa for entry to Nepal - visas can be obtained on entry at Kathmandu airport. Requirements include 2 passport size photographs, completed visa form and a visa fee (starting from \$25).

#### *INDIA*

Travellers can transit India without a visa providing they hold onward confirmed reservations to a third country and do not leave the transit area. If you are going to leave the transit area eg. to stay in a hotel overnight or to travel in India, you will need to apply for a visa. Visa applications are processed by Indian Visa Application Centres in London, Birmingham, Manchester, Hayes, Cardiff, Glasgow and Edinburgh. The costs start from £25 for a transit visa. At present there are no specific and compulsory health requirements for entry to Nepal, India or Bhutan if you are arriving from North America, Europe or Australia. However, we encourage you to consult your doctor in good time (at least 6 weeks before departure) about updating your immunisation against Hepatitis A, polio, tetanus and typhoid or anything else they consider advisable.
